A MESSAGE FROM OUR DEPUTY HEAD OF SCHOOL

While doing so, we affirm how important our classmates and friends are to us, and we to them. It is the same in spaces where faculty and staff gather to work and to be.

LUCAS B. IS BA'S AWARDEE OF THE 2023 HARVARD GLOBALWE ESSAY CONTEST



Congratulations to Lucas B. for being the Beacon Academy's awardee of the 2023 Harvard GlobalWE Essay Writing Contest. The annual competition is open to Grade 11 students who must write a response to the prompt: What is the biggest challenge facing women and girls in your home country today? This year, judges from the Harvard Alumni for Global Women's Empowerment chose Lucas's essay discussing the status of reproductive health and education in the Philippines.

The Harvard Alumni for Global Women's Empowerment is a shared interest group comprised of Harvard alumni who are "dedicated to the empowerment of women through education, dialogue and connection among individuals working for women's rights and freedoms worldwide." The organization promotes its advocacy by hosting the annual competition in selected schools all over the world, inviting students to "think critically about the status and rights of women." Grade 11 students submit their work to the GlobalWE judging committee, and one winning essay is selected for each participating school. Lucas joins previous Beacon Academy winners, Cristina R. (Batch '21) and Hannah T. (Batch '22).
