SCHOLARSHIP OFFERINGS

Incoming Grade 9-11 students may apply. All applicants must successfully pass the admissions process screening before applying for any scholarship or financial aid grant.

The Beacon Academy provides students from all backgrounds the opportunity to receive and succeed in a meaningful, globally recognized education that will enable them to enter a local or international college best fit for their talents, and who will, in the future, make a positive contribution to the country.

Aligned to this vision, the Beacon Academy provides assistance through scholarship and financial aid awards to deserving students from social, economic, and cultural backgrounds.

Merit Scholarship

These are annual non-repayable awards of financial assistance to students who have successfully passed the Admissions screening process. Each applicant may apply for only one of the four available merit scholarship categories.

- **Academic Excellence**
- **Athletic Excellence**
- **Creative Excellence**
- **Excellence in Leadership and Community Service**

Each applicant may apply for only one of the four available merit scholarship categories.

Financial Aid

These are annual, non-repayable awards of financial assistance to deserving students with demonstrated financial need who have successfully passed the admissions screening process and who fulfill the criteria that reflects the values and purposes of the institution. Recipients of this aid enjoy up to 100% discount on tuition, and the waiver of capital development and matriculation fees. Financial aid is granted to Filipino citizens and to one child per family.

LIST OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Letter of Intent written by the student applicant stating the type of scholarship applied for and the reason behind the scholarship application.
- Portfolio of Achievements (e.g. significant works, certificates, citations, photos of awards or medals, summary of accomplishments). Please upload supporting documents in PDF, JPEG, JPG, or PNG format. Kindly ensure that each item is properly labelled (i.e event, type of award/citation, year received).
- Copy of Income Tax Return of EACH parent/legal guardian for the past two (2) years showing all sources of income.
- Current certificate(s) of employment stating the designation or position in the company and annual salary of EACH parent/guardian.
- BIR Form 2316 or Certificate of Compensation Payment/Tax Withheld of both parents/guardian.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FINANCIAL AID APPLICANTS

- Exterior photo of permanent residence
- Exterior photo(s) of vehicles owned or regularly used
- Proof of ongoing financial obligations showing monthly payments (e.g., loans, mortgage, vehicle payments, and other debts), and educational payments for other children, if applicable.

Given the competitive nature of scholarship applications, the Scholarship Committee may require additional time for careful review and deliberation. Scholarship results will be sent to your registered email address on or before May 15, 2026.

To help us proceed smoothly with your child's scholarship application, please ensure that all required forms, including the recommendation form, are fully accomplished and submitted on or before the deadline.
